Program Information

DreamWrights Youth and Family Theatre is once again excited to offer an intensive course for those with a serious interest in musical theater. Students will be expected to fine-tune audition skills, stretch theatrical muscles, exercise musical ability, create characters, and of course, have fun. Our work will proudly culminate with the production of the beloved classic comedy musical, *Once Upon a Mattress* which is a rollicking spin on the familiar classic, *The Princess and the Pea*. The show includes wonderful songs, hilarious tunes. And a little romance. All of which combine into some side-splitting shenanigans. The workshop is open to those between the ages of 12 to 20 who are willing to work hard both in and out of the classroom.

Audition Information

This class starts with an unusual audition process in which *attendance is expected for both sessions on May 17 and 19 at 6:00*. On May 17 students will audition and receive a review of their performance. All students will have an opportunity to fine-tune their work and *must return* on May 19 to audition a second time.

For the audition, students are required to:

- *Deliver a memorized monologue.
- *Perform approximately 16 bars of an up-tempo song.
- *Perform approximately 16 bars of a ballad or similar tempo song.

Songs may be performed a cappella, with an accompaniment tape, or bring music for our accompanist to play with you.

- * Bring the attached Student Application to the auditions, completed and signed.

NOTE: Your DreamWrights class registration is separate from the student application and must be sent to DreamWrights before auditions. Your payment will be held until the show is cast.
