



# DreamWrights 2010 Summer Camps

## Youth & Family Theatre

All Camps Run Monday through Friday

Full Day 9-3

Half Day 9-12 or 1-4

Take two half day camps in the same week and stay for lunch in a supervised setting

\*\* These camps culminate in longer or multiple performances.

### ★ Camp 1, 2, A, B, C, D & 29

#### Half Day – Creativity Camp (Ages 5-7)

Younger campers get an opportunity to experience and learn about aspects of theatre through children's literature, games, crafts and movement. All activities are designed to help the campers explore the vast world of their imaginations.

### ★ Camp 3, 16 (Ages 7-9) & 27 (Ages 10-13)

#### Full Day – Creativity Camp

Each camp allows the camper to explore his/her imagination and build self confidence. The participants will learn about live theatre via movement, improvisation and a variety of other creative arts (e.g. puppetry, music, dance, visual arts, storytelling, painting and creating small sets and props etc.)

### ★ Camp 4

#### Half Day – Auditioning and Acting Skills (Ages 10-16)

The campers will work on building confidence in auditioning and performing. They will explore what is expected at different types of auditions, the preparation process and appropriate audition behaviors.

### ★ Camp 5

#### Half Day – Movement for Actors (Ages 10-16)

Actors need to be comfortable in their own skin and confident in moving on stage. Through guided activities learn how to develop specific character's physicality through exercises that study body language, movement dynamics and motivation.

### ★ Camp 6 & 20

#### Full Day- Jr. Production Camp (Ages 7-10)

##### *Rupert Meets Mrs. Tales*

This camp provides the opportunity to be part of a fully mounted production. The campers will rehearse and perform DreamWrights' *Rupert Meets Mrs. Tales*. Great for beginning actors and those who love to perform.

### ★ Camp 7

#### \*\*Full Day – Jr. Musical Theatre (Ages 8-16)

##### *The Princess and the Pauper*

The Jr. Musical Theatre experience will dive deep into the world of musical theatre. The camper will develop characters and improve his/her musical theatre skills. Come sing, dance and act out the DreamWrights' original musical *The Princess and the Pauper* based on the *Prince and the Pauper* by Mark Twain.

### ★ Camp 8

#### Full Day- Crafting Props (Ages 8-11)

Crafting Props is for those who enjoy working on art projects. They will explore the many different techniques of creating props. Learn how to take everyday items and craft them into unbelievable stage props. Their creations will be featured in the Jr. Musical Theatre Production.

### ★ Camp 9 (Ages 7-10) & 10 (Ages 11-13)

#### Half Day – Dance and More I & II

These camps are for anyone who wants to dance. Campers will work together to create dances that will be performed to the music of some of today's high energy musicals. High School Musical, Hairspray, and Grease are some of the possible choices.

### ★ Camp 11

#### Full Day – Acting Ensemble (Ages 7-9)

Ensemble work teaches campers about the importance of working together for the success of a theatre experience. Campers will work on character building and engage themselves in fun group building games and activities.

### ★ Camp 12

#### Full Day – Acting Thru the Ages (Ages 10-14)

Explore the history and arts of theatre. The campers will journey through different time periods by investigating acting styles and techniques, sets, costumes, and social situations of the time. Come participate in theatre's exciting history.

### ★ Camp 13

#### Full Day – Expression Collection (Ages 14-17)

Get a better understanding of dance technique. The class will start with Ballet and Jazz, and then explore the diversity of dance through Broadway, Modern, Hip-Hop and African and different decades of dance and movement styles.

### ★ Camp 14

#### Full Day – Technical Theatre (Ages 13-18)

Interested in the arts of light, sound and set? This camp gives the camper an overview by designing, implementing and running these elements. You can see some of their designs at the Sr. Production Camp's performance of *Lost & Foundling*.

### ★ Camp 15

#### \*\*Full Day- Sr. Production Camp (Ages 13-18)

##### *Lost and Foundling*

This camp culminates in a full length production. Join Pryce, a teenager who has grown up in the mega-store PriceMart, in her journey of self-discovery. She encounters obstacles such as the Neverending Line, the Free Samples Person and the dreaded Price Slasher.

### ★ Camp 17

#### Full Day-Broadway Bound (Ages 13-17)

For the Broadway guru! It's time to put your dancing shoes on as we jump into the Broadway style. Campers will bring characters to life through dance and movement. Come prepared to dance the days away with music from some of your favorite Broadway shows!

### ★ Camp 18 (Ages 10-14) & 25 (Ages 7-10)

#### Half Day- Acting for Musical Theatre

Campers will learn to use his/her voice, both speaking and singing, to express character traits and emotions. Using scenes from the genre of musical theatre the camper will learn techniques that will help preserve the voice and build on creating strong characters.

### ★ Camp 19 (Ages 10-14) & 26 (Ages 7-10)

#### Half Day- Group Singing: Exploring the Musical Theatre Chorus

Learn important vocal skills such as blending, keeping your voice healthy, correct posture, breathing, diction and expressive singing. The camper will explore singing with a group, using popular musical theatre chorus songs. Come be a part of a great group dynamic.

### ★ Camp 21

#### Full Day- Musical Theatre Skills (Ages 9-12)

Campers will work on their musical theatre skills by focusing on the areas of acting, singing and dancing. The camp will help to prepare students for musical theatre auditions and the musical theatre experience.

### ★ Camp 22 (Ages 11-16) & 31 (Ages 7-10)

#### Full Day- Mission Improvable Sr. & Jr.

The mission, if you wish to accept, is for the camper to find the fun and freedom to live in the moment. Improv helps the student become a more confident and spontaneous actor. Come unleash your creative spirit!

### ★ Camp 23

#### Full Day- Playwriting (Ages 11-16)

Campers will follow specific playwriting formats to create an original piece. They will be encouraged to think outside of the box, and participate in a series of workshops to create exciting characters and plots. Support our playwrights by seeing their play on July 30 performed and directed by their peers.

### ★ Camp 24

#### Full Day- Directing and Acting (Ages 11-16)

Students will be exposed to the responsibilities of the director and actor. They will do hands-on activities such as creating a prompt book, working on directing and listening to their peers. Using the script from the playwriting class, students will develop their new skills.

### ★ Camp 28

#### Half Day- The Fantastic Fours (Age 4)

This camp is for the four year old thespian! This active camp will include singing, dancing, crafting, costumes and acting. Campers will share a performance on the final day.

### ★ Camp 30

#### Full Day- Step Back In Time! (Ages 11-19)

Come spend a week with Lady Rochester, Sir Willem, Master Young and many other Renaissance friends! The camper will be transported back in time to the Renaissance and learn about games, clothing, language, dances, songs and practice sword play. Lady Rochester has fun, new activities for you!

As an added bonus, on Wednesday, campers will attend the Pennsylvania Renaissance Faire Youth Day. Camper's admission to the Faire is included in the cost of the camp.
