Thematic Context: Kevin is a wealthy, progressive Black professional who initially uses humor and diplomacy to keep the real estate deal moving forward, but his patience erodes when white privilege is weaponized.

Kevin Audition Monologue (Act II)

(To Steve, dropping his easygoing demeanor after Steve makes a defensive comment about race.)

"Hold on, Steve. Let's not do that. Let's not pretend that you're the one being victimized here because people are asking you to be mindful. Nobody is trying to trap you. My wife is trying to explain to you that when you buy a house in a historically Black neighborhood, tear it down, and build a structure that physically blocks out the sun for the neighbors who have lived here for forty years, it sends a message. It says your comfort matters more than their history. I've been sitting here trying to keep the peace and laugh off the little comments, but don't look at us like we're being unreasonable just because we're asking you to show a shred of cultural awareness."
